Maasheggen UNESCO: essential facts

- 2000 hectares and a total of 275 kilometres of woven hedges;
- Since 2018 UNESCO Man & Biopshere. In biopshere reserves, the relationship between people and their living environment is the central focus;
- The Maasheggen UNQESCO biosphere reserve stretches along the Maas river in the municipality Land van Cuijk;
- In the Maasheggen area, like a string of beads, there are 11 villages (about 60,000 inhabitants)






THE MAASHEGGEN IN 1731






THE MAASHEGGEN – NORTH (environment Oeffelt – Beugen)






THE MAASHEGGEN – SOUTH (environment Sambeek - Vierlingsbeek)














WEAVING HEDGES

Weaving hedges: a thousandyear-old technique

Farmers weave the hedges using a special technique.

The hedges form an rock-solid boundary for livestock, but also protect against predators. They are so strong that they remain standing at high tide and retain fertile river clay. The hedges. also provide shelter from rain, wind and sun, allowing grass to grow harder and cattle to stay outside for a month longer.
